NOTICE

There has been an increase of over 40% in the number of psychologists Registered in Ontario, and an increase to more than double the work of the Board of Examiners since 1970. The Board has found it most difficult under the current arrangement to meet, adequately, either its community responsibility, or the requirements placed upon it by a greatly increased number of Registered psychologists. There are a growing number of complex problems presented by increases in applications for registration and the necessity to investigate and act upon complaints against psychologists and others which are not being met.

The Board has decided, therefore, to institute a full-time office and is, consequently seeking the services of a full-time Registrar.

The Registrar, working under the direction of the Board, will be expected: to develop, institute and monitor application, examination and registration procedures; to act in a liaison capacity between candidates for application and the Board; to represent the Board to the community-atlarge; to work with Board members and/or legal counsel in dealing with complaints against psychologists and others; in arranging for hearings before the Board; and in carrying out directives of the Board concerning these matters.

The Registrar will be responsible, in addition for developing systems to provide information to assist the Board in its deliberations affecting psychology and psychologists in Ontario.

The task, which will be an interesting one during this time of transition, calls for good judgement, strength of character, tact and patience. The Registrar must be a registered psychologist in or willing to locate in Toronto and it is desirable that the person selected take up duties as soon as possible.

The starting salary is negotiable within a range of \$18,000 - \$25,000, depending upon qualifications and experience. Usual fringe benefits will be provided.
