President's Message

As I begin my sixth year on Council, I also begin my year as President of the College. It promises to be an exciting and challenging year as we continue to regulate the profession of psychology and protect the public interest. We have six new members of Council this year, an unprecedented turnover of members in recent history. As well as having three newly elected professional members, we also have two new academic members and one new public member.

There are some major issues that face us as a College. We continue to develop proposed regulation amendments. One of these has to do with registration such that much of what are now guidelines will become regulations and will make clearer what is expected of applicants for registration in Ontario. Another is related to quality assurance and continuing professional development. These proposed regulation amendments have been distributed to stakeholders, including members, so that we all have an opportunity to review them and provide feedback. I encourage you to take that opportunity.

An ongoing issue for the College is the recommendation coming from the Taskforce on Shaping the Future of Psychology in Ontario. You will recall that in March 2013, the Council voted that, on a fixed date yet to be determined, all members of the College would be given the title of Psychologist and the College would cease registering masters level applicants. This is a policy decision and has not yet been approved by government. The implementation plan for those recommendations is being prepared. All members will be kept apprised of developments through the stakeholder consultation process.

The majority of the members of the College use email as their primary source of information from the College. You are encouraged to ensure that we have your current email address so that you are kept up-to-date with the activities of the College.

As I write this note, it is incredibly warm outside. Summer has begun. I hope that all members and staff of the College of Psychologists of Ontario have a safe and happy summer.

Council Highlights – June 21, 2013

The Registrar welcomed [six new Council members](#) and a new Executive Committee was elected for the 2013-2014 year. Robert Gauthier, M.Sc., M.Ed., C.Psych.Assoc. was elected President and Lise Mercier, Ph.D., C.Psych. was elected Vice-President.

Strategic Issues

Council was advised that, during Mental Health Week in May, the College published a print advertisement in a supplement focused on mental health in a national newspaper.

Policy issues

Proposal for Implementation of Policy Decision to Close Master's Level Registration

The Registrar presented a draft proposal for implementation of the policy decision to discontinue master's level registration, register psychological associates as psychologists and develop a mechanism for evaluating internationally trained applicants. The draft document is to be considered by the Registration Committee and discussed informally with selected stakeholders prior to discussion at the October 2013 Council meeting, with a view to approving a version for formal consultation with stakeholders. Closure of master's level registration and the other proposed changes would require Government approval of amendments to the registration regulation.

Regulation Updates

Following discussions between representatives of the College and Ministry staff, some changes were made to the draft amendments to the Registration Regulation and the Quality Assurance Regulation that were submitted to the Ministry in mid-2012. As some of these changes may be viewed as substantive, Council directed that the current drafts of the regulations be circulated to College members and other stakeholders for final comment.

Bill 70: Regulated Health Professions Amendment Act (Spousal Exception)

Council directed that a letter be written to the Minister of Health indicating that the College did not support the Bill as it could weaken the current protections in the legislation.

By-Law amendments

[Bylaw 22, Professional Liability Insurance](#) was approved with the amendment to remove the necessity for "personal" insurance coverage and the clarification that a member must be covered by professional liability insurance for every setting in which the member provides psychological services.

Business issues

Feedback regarding the recent Barbara Wand Seminar indicated that both the seminar and the webcast were well received.

Other Business

The Council approved the following dates for future meetings: October 4, 2013, December 13, 2013 and March 21, 2014.

New Council Members

Patricia Minnes, Ph.D., C.Psych. (Academic Member)

Dr. Patricia Minnes, is a professor in the Departments of Psychology and Psychiatry and the School of Rehabilitation Therapy at Queen's University in Kingston Canada. She also works with the Developmental Disabilities Consulting Program, an interprofessional team serving individuals with developmental disabilities and mental health/behavioural challenges and their families. Dr. Minnes was the DCT of the Queen's Program in Clinical Psychology from 1996-2007. Her research and practice focus on inclusion and health needs of children and adults with developmental disabilities, and wellbeing of families. Dr. Minnes is principal investigator on a CIHR funded emerging research team: HELPS Inc investigating: Health, Education and Learning Partnerships Promoting Social Inclusion of Children with Developmental Delays and Disabilities and a co-principal investigator on a second CIHR team : Go4Kidds investigating: Great Outcomes for Kids Impacted by Severe Developmental Disabilities and their Families.

Walter Mittelstaedt, Ph.D., C.Psych. (Academic Member)

Dr. Mittelstaedt received his Honour's B.A. from the University of Waterloo, and M.A. and Ph.D. in Clinical Psychology from the University of Saskatchewan in 1985 and 1989, respectively. He is a Registered Psychologist and has been Director of the Centre for Mental Health Research at the University of Waterloo since 2008. Prior to joining the University of Waterloo full-time, he held positions as staff psychologist at Cambridge Memorial Hospital (1989-91) and Lutherwood Children's Mental Health Services (1991-96). From 1996-2008 Walter held senior management positions at Lutherwood including Director of Mental Health Services and Director of Strategic. In addition, Walter has had a part-time private practice in psychology, supervised clinical Ph.D. students since 1997, and has taught graduate level clinical courses since 2006. He holds adjunct Assistant Professor positions at the University of Waterloo Department of Psychology and Assistant Clinical Professor (adjunct) at McMaster Faculty of Health Sciences. In the past, he has published academic articles on self-blame, perfectionism and clinical psychology training. His current research interest is in the area of mechanisms of effectiveness in psychotherapy. He is a member of The Canadian and American Psychological Associations and an affiliate of Social Innovation Generation (SIG@Waterloo). He has sat on a number of committees, planning groups and boards throughout his career including the Ontario Psychological Association (1994-98) and Canadian Mental Health Association (Waterloo Region Branch - 1990-92).

Kristin Bisbee (Public Member)

Kristin Bisbee is a licensed paralegal with the Law Society of Upper Canada. She attended Seneca College for paralegal studies and has completed a certificate in Alternative Dispute Resolution. She is Owner/Legal Researcher/Licensed Paralegal of Madolyn Legal Services and

is also a paralegal with M.D. Paralegal Services. Previous employment includes the position of Operations Support Manager with Bodycote Thermal Processing Canada, Inc. Ms. Bisbee's past community involvement includes volunteering with the Yellow Brick House, the Ontario Justice Education Network and the Halton Women's Shelter.

By-Law 22: Professional Liability Insurance

This by-law is made under the authority of the Regulated Health Professions Act, 1991 as amended, and the Psychology Act, 1991 as amended.

22.1 Subject to section 6, each member of the College registered with a certificate of registration authorizing autonomous practice, interim autonomous practice or supervised practice shall hold or otherwise be covered by professional liability insurance for all settings in which the member practices.

22.2 The amount of insurance coverage shall be no less than \$2,000,000.

22.3 The insurance shall have no deductible.

22.4 On or before June 1 of each year, every member described in section 1 shall confirm to the College, normally through the annual renewal process;

- (a) that the member has valid existing professional liability insurance in place; and
- (b) the name of the insurer providing the liability insurance.

22.5 Each member upon being registered for the first time or whose certificate of registration has been reinstated shall, within 30 days of registration, confirm to the College, in a manner required by the College:

- (a) that the member has valid existing professional liability insurance in place; and
- (b) the name of the insurer providing the liability insurance.

22.6 Exemptions from the requirement under section 1 apply only to:

(1) Any member who resides outside of Ontario and who provides no psychological services within Ontario at any time during the registration year, nor supervises anyone in the provision of psychological services in Ontario.

(2) Any member who holds academic status and who provides no psychological services within Ontario at any time during the registration year, nor supervises anyone in the provision of psychological services in Ontario.

(3) Any member who holds retired status and who provides no psychological services within Ontario at any time during the registration year, nor supervises anyone in the provision of psychological services in Ontario.

(4) Any member who attests that:

- (a) the member has provided no direct services to individuals or families, nor conducted psychological research with individuals or families within Ontario during the preceding registration year; and,
- (b) the member has provided no supervision to anyone in the provision of such services nor the conduct of such research in Ontario during the preceding registration year; and,
- (c) the member will not be providing such services, conducting such research nor providing such supervision in the current registration year.

22.7 If required to do so by the Registrar, a member must provide proof of insurance coverage within 30 days.

With Regret

The College has learned of the passing of several members who have made significant contributions to the regulation of psychology in Ontario.

Dr. David Rennie became a member of the College of Psychologists in 1973, and was a Board Member from 1990-1992 of the Ontario Board of Examiners in Psychology (OBEP). He was also a member of the Transitional Council (1992-1993) of the College of Psychologists of Ontario and participated as a member of College committees and as an Oral Examiner until 2006.

Dr. Brian Ridgley, a psychologist since 1971, was a Board Member of the Ontario Board of Examiners in Psychology from 1991 to 1992. He went on to become a member of the Transitional Council of the College of Psychologists of Ontario from 1992 to 1994, acting as Chair from 1992 to 1993. Dr. Ridgley contributed his expertise as an Oral Examiner and to College committees until 2003.

Dr. Harley Wideman was one of the first psychologists registered by the Ontario Board of Examiners in Psychology, having been given the registration number 4 in 1961. He remained a registered psychologist for 51 years until 2012. He was an original member of the Provisional Board from 1960 to 1961 of the Ontario Board of Examiners in Psychology and continued as a member of the OBEP Board from 1961 to 1964.


