COVID-19 Vaccine Appointment Information for Members Second Notice

Dear Members,

You are receiving this email because you either work or live in Halton Region according to the information you have provided to the College. If this is not the case, please disregard this notice and take steps to correct the information provided.

Halton Region Public Health has asked the College to notify members who work or live in their district that you may be eligible to book your COVID-19 vaccine appointment. Please carefully read the notice from Halton Region Public Health: *Any Health Care Worker who cannot work from home now eligible for COVID-19* available [here](#).

Halton Region Public Health wishes to communicate the following:

Any remaining health care workers who cannot work from home, and who live or work in Halton will be eligible to book an appointment for vaccination at a community clinic as of **Friday, April 16, 2021**.

Health Care Workers include custodial, security, reception and other staff. As of April 16, eligible health care workers can book their COVID-19 vaccine appointment online at: halton.ca/COVIDvaccines.

To be eligible to receive the COVID-19 vaccine, health care workers must:

- **work or live in Halton Region AND**
- **not work from home.**

If you are working remotely full-time, please do not book an appointment at this time. As vaccine supply increases, eligibility will be expanded.
